Mentor Candidate's 'proof of qualifications' must be received by PICFI and approved by the Registration Deadline to permit the Candidate to proceed for training. If interested in this Mentoring Program please bring all documentation to Dana by Friday January 21, 2012.

This is what is required:

1. Knowledge and Experience as a Fishing Vessel Operator
SVOP (or above), Coastal Navigation Certificate, Certificate Exemption Declaration, Proof of 7 fishing seasons as master and operator in charge of a fishing vessel less than 15gt with no two seasons in the same calendar year
2. Knowledge of Mechanical and Vessel Maintenance
Proof of 7 fishing seasons experience as person responsible for the maintenance of a fishing vessel
3. Knowledge and Experience in Safety on board the Fishing Vessel
Marine Emergency Duties level A3 (or above), Valid First Aid Certificate and Fishing Vessel Stability
4. Knowledge and Experience of Designated Fishery
Proof of 5 seasons experience participating in the fishery to which the individual is applying for recognition as a Mentor
5. Industry Leadership Character Reference
Proof in the form of a Letter of Reference as to being a respected person in the fishing with many of the following qualities: demonstrated leadership or mentorship skills; known for teaching inexperienced crew with respect and patience; understands fisheries management and environmental issues; knowledgeable in quality fish handling; practices 'safety first' policies at all times; willing to agree and follow the Mentor's Code of Practice

Proof of meeting the minimum requirements of the above Elements must be in the form of a copy of the Training Certificate, Certificate of Competency or Certificate of Completion from the Training Provider or Regulatory Authority.
